- Bids to be evaluated and awarded upon best overall value.
- AYLAA reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities / minor irregularities in a bid.
- All stock contractors are responsible for the dropping off/ picking up, feeding, watering, and doctoring of their livestock.
- AYLAA will not transport feed for livestock to rodeos.
- AYLAA makes no guarantee on total number of Rodeos and/or entries.
- AYLAA reserves the right to use multiple contractors to meet stock requirements.
- AYLAA event director has the right to refuse or disqualify use of livestock if not seen fit for event or in unhealthy enough to compete in the event.
- Team Roping Stock must have horn wraps.
- Steer Riding Steers must be uniform in size and weight. See AYLAA Rule Book for specifics.
- Calf Riding calves must be approved calves by director.
- All Steers must have their horns tipped or cut back to a minimum of a U.S. 25 cent piece.
- All bulls must have their horns tipped or cut back to a minimum of a U.S. 25 cent piece.
- AYLAA reserves the right to provide own bull fighters if they so choose to do so.
- All Goats must have their horns tipped or cut back to a minimum of a U.S. 10 cent piece.
